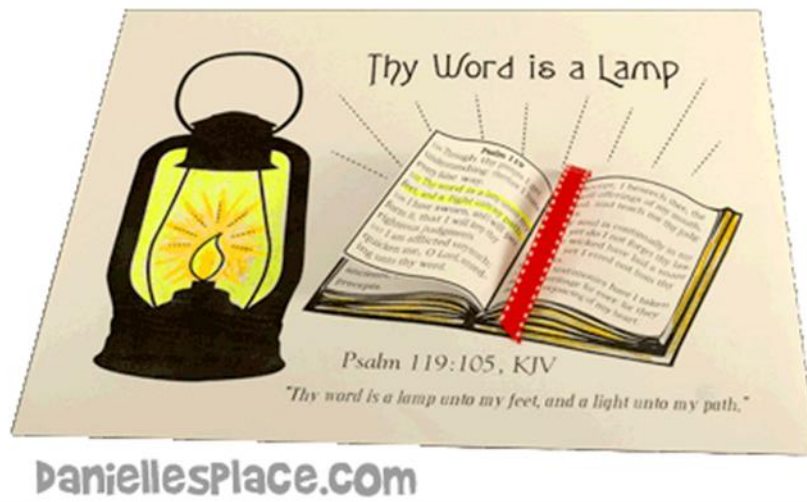


Psalm 119:105
"Thy Word is a Lamp" Activity Sheet



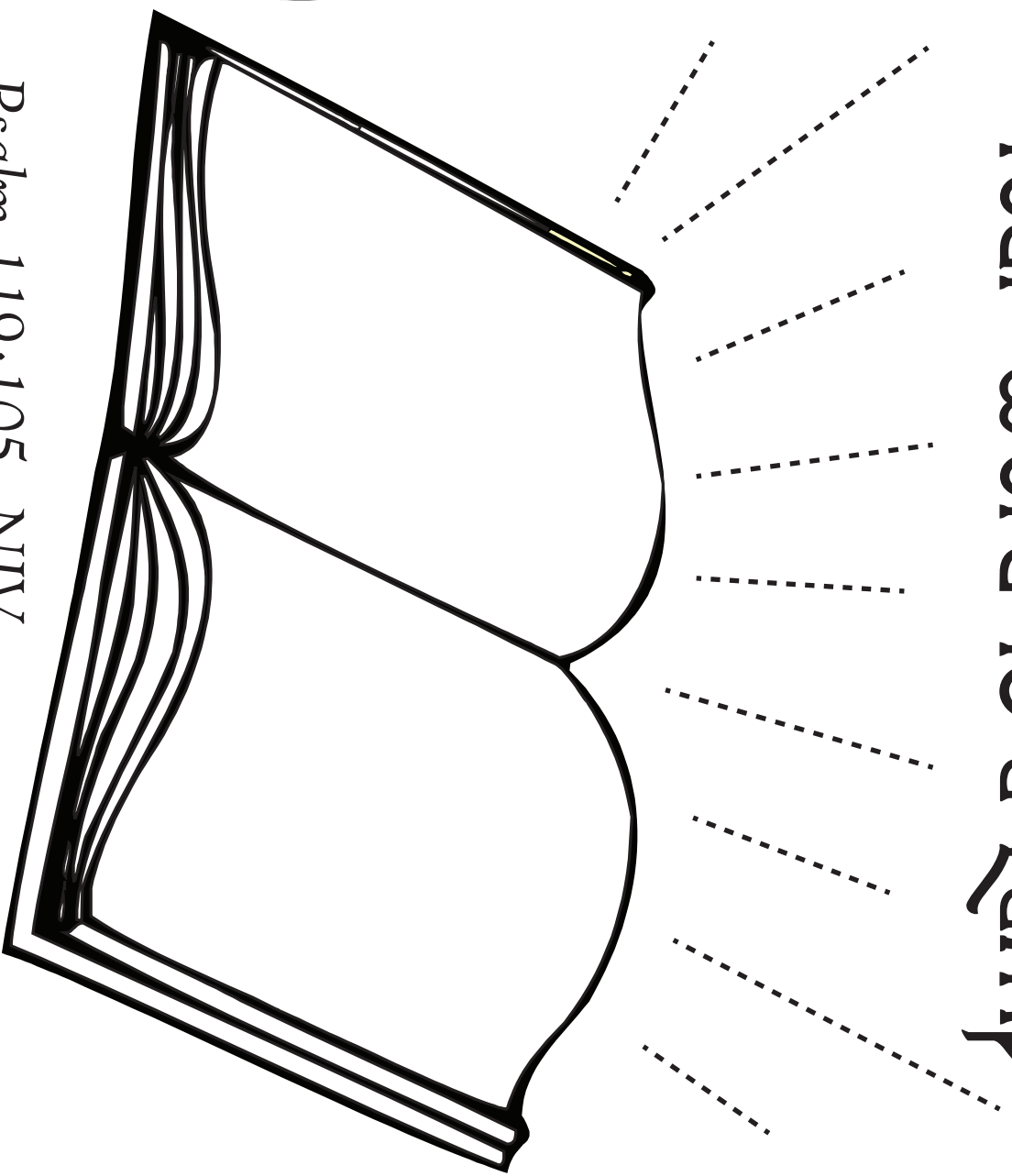
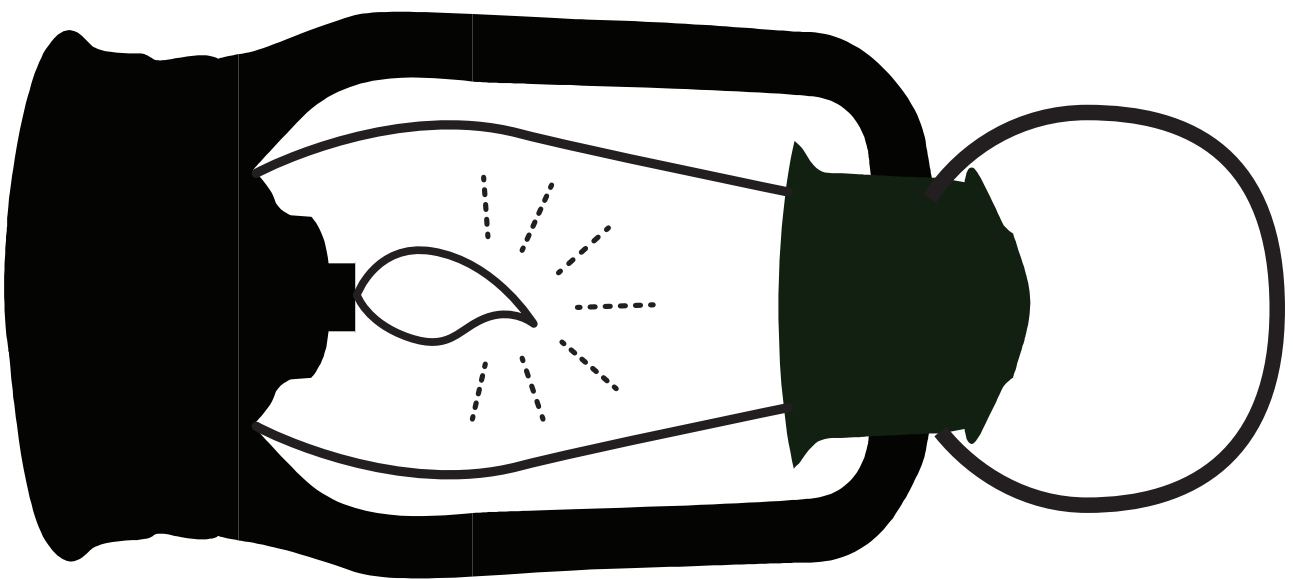
What you will need:

- Highlighter Markers or crayons
- Glue
- Ribbon
- Scissors
- Activity Sheet Patterns printed

What to do:

1. Print out the patterns. Cut out the Bible pages and fold them in half. Cut ribbon into five-inch length.
2. Color the picture with highlighter markers.
3. Glue the ribbon onto the right-hand side of the Bible on the activity sheet so that it will fold down over the Bible when they are attached.
4. Glue the left side of the Bible pages, Psalm 119:98-103 to the left side of the Bible pattern, and then glue the left side of the Psalm 119:104-111 to the back of the Psalm 119:101-103 and the right side to the right side of the Bible on the activity sheet.
5. Find Psalm 119:105 on the Bible pages and use a highlighter markers to highlight the verse.
